

Inflow of foreign direct investment to Czechia (€ billion)






Czechia is one of the most successful transition economies in terms of attracting foreign direct investment. The introduction of investment incentives in 1998 stimulated a massive inflow of FDI to both greenfield and brownfield projects. As an early reformer in east-central Europe, Czechia led the way in the early 1990s in adopting far-reaching stabilisation, liberalisation and privatisation programmes. The imple-mentation of EU rules and regulations has also helped to improve the country's business environment and attract FDI.

FDI screening in Czechia

Czechia implements its **national screening mechanism** in accordance with Act No. 34/2021 Coll. on screening of foreign investments, which has entered into effect on **May 1, 2021**.

The law is focusing on foreign investors with the ultimate beneficial owner from non-EU countries. At the same time, the investment typically counts for 10% or higher share in targeted Czech company active in sector important for the security, public, or internal order of Czechia. If the company does business in the field of production of military material, selected dual-use goods, or belongs to critical or critical information infrastructure, the investor will have to ask for consent by the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MOIT) with the investment before its completion.

The absolute majority of foreign investors in Czechia does not pose any risk and their investments are not problematic from the security perspective. Foreign investors are welcome in Czechia and the Czech national screening mechanism is designed to limit any substantial administrative burden.

FDI inflow to Czechia by country and sector

FDI inflow totalled EUR 7.65 billion in 2021.

The most important investors are the United States, Luxembourg, Germany and the Netherlands. A significant portion of FDI inflows into Czechia has been concentrated in the automotive-components sector. The services sector, especially software, IT and financial services, has been the second-largest beneficiary. More investment is now being directed towards more high-technology sectors and research and development.


