



## PRIVACY POLICY

### PERSONAL DATA

Your data is collected by Severská obchodní komora v České republice, Business Identification Number: 62413350, with its registered seat at Praha 1 - Nové Město, Václavské náměstí 1282/51, Post Code 110 00, registered with the Commercial Register maintained by the Municipal Court in Prague, section A, insert 13081 (hereinafter the "**Chamber**") and is subject to a processing by the Chamber as the controller. The information and data concerning you shall be used for purposes of your participation on events organised or co-organised by the Chamber and, further for purposes of marketing and promotion of events organised or co-organised by the Chamber or any of its members. The legal basis for the processing of the data for the purpose of marketing and promotion of events is your consent given in the application form of a particular event organised by the Chamber.

The provision of personal data for the purpose of your participation on events organised or co-organised by the Chamber is a contractual requirement. The provision of data for such purpose is necessary to enter into an agreement on participation on an event and you as the data subject are obliged to provide the data. If you do not provide the data, the Chamber cannot fulfil the obligations from the above agreement.

According to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016, you have the right of access, rectification, erasure (right to be forgotten) and transfer (portability) data concerning you. In addition, you can request a restriction or object the processing of your data.
