The Road Towards a More Gender Equal Labour Market

Sweden was the first country to replace maternity leave with parental leave, in 1974. Today, Sweden ranks as the fifth most gender equal country according to the World Economic Forum. Although each society needs to find its own path towards a more gender equal labour market, it is important to share experiences and best practices with each other.

At the seminar Mr. Niklas Löfgren from The Swedish Social Insurance Agency, Mr. Josef Středula from the Czech-Moravian Confederation of Trade Unions (CMKOS) and representatives from the Government, business and civil society will participate and encourage a discussion about the Swedish and Czech roads to a socially sustainable and gender equal labour market.
